LORAN SCHOLARSHIP—Up to \$100,000

Due: October 13

Character, service and leadership are the selection criteria for the Loran Scholar program. Loran Scholars are people of strong moral character who have demonstrated commitment to service and potential as leaders.

The Loran Scholar program is open to every graduating high school student from coast-to-coast. Renewable for up to four years, and valued up to &100,000, it includes an annual tuition waiver and a stipend of \$9,000, access to funding and internships through our summer program, invitations to annual gathering and forums, and one-on-one mentorship. To be eligible, applicants must have earned a minimum cumulative average of 85% in the previous three academic years and be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident. Planning for Post-Secondary Grade 12 Checklist

October

- Check your calendar...are any of your admission application deadlines comping up?
TIP: Most of these application forms can be completed and submitted online. Apply Alberta is a great place to start. It is an online application system that will let students apply to one or more post-secondary institutions and authorize transcript transfers between participating institutions in the province.
- Continue to check and apply for scholarships from both public and private sources such as churches, community groups, the government or minority organizations.
- To get financial aid, you have to apply for it. Visit the Student Aid website to apply for financial aid, or talk with your high school guidance counsellor for more information.
TIP: Some post-secondary schools have separate financial aid application forms called institutional aid applications. Do some research and find out if this is an available option for you!

You Should Know....

- Your transcript must be sent with your admission application, so keep working hard on your grades!
- If you have to move away from home, start researching possible places to live or contact the housing office at the post-secondary school you plan on attending for more info.
- Check to see if you school of choice is hosting an Open House-many do in the fall, so this is a great opportunity to visit the campus and learn more about your program options.

High School Graduation Basics

The Minimum Formula

High School Diploma Minimum Requirements

- ☑ Earn 105 Credits (min is 100)
- ☑ English 30 (1 or 2)
- ☑ Social 30 (1 or 2)
- ☑ CALM
- ☑ PE 10
- ☑ Math 20 (1, 2 or 3)
- ☑ Science 20 (Sci 20, Bio 20, Chem 20, Phy 20, Sci 24)
- ☑ 10 Credits from CTS, Fine Arts (art, drama, music), Second Language, PE 20 or 30, RAP.
- ☑ 10 Other Grade 12 Credits, options **may** include Work Experience, RAP, Green Certificate, CTS Credits at the 30 level (example HCS 3000) any core course

Because a course meets diploma requirements does not mean it meets post secondary entrance requirements.



Certificate of Completion

- Not as many requirements but often needs diligent checking to make sure credits are completed correctly.




Reminder
